NEW HORIZONS FOR SENIORS PROGRAM

The Caledon Seniors Centre is pleased to announce that we have received partial funding under the Government of Canada's **New Horizons for Seniors Program** for two projects – a new Billiard Table and a new Multimedia Projector.

The federal grants and contributions program supports projects that are led or inspired by Seniors who are making a difference in the lives of others in their communities.
